Class Time:

Attendance:

*Success is based upon attendance. Therefore, if you miss more than 10 classes during the year you will be asked to drop the course. The only exemptions are absences due to illness (verified by a note) and school-based activities. You will not be excused to write tests, or attend tutorials etc. For Sr. Lion Pride, attendance is worth marks. Absences and lates will result in a deduction even if excused. The Leadership Executive will take attendance at 7:10am so don't be LATE!
