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Welcome To the Core program this program offers a flexible approach to your graduation while helping you to gain valuable skills, experiences, and credentials.

Course Description

This program has three components:

1. CORE Curriculum

- developed by the Construction Association and approved by the Industry Training Authority, successful completion of this curriculum will earn you several advantages.
 - a. Certification in
 - WHMIS
 - level 1 of first aid
 - fall protection/ladder safety
 - traffic control (flag person)
 - b. Development of technical skills and knowledge
 - c. 360 hours toward your first year apprenticeship (recognized by the ITA)
 - d. 16 credits toward grade 12 graduation

2. Work Experience/Transitions

- you will complete requirements for Transitions 12
- you will have a 3 week out of school work experience. This work may be in a field in which you are interested in pursuing an apprenticeship.

3. Completion of 1 course, which you require for graduation. This course will be administered by the Abbotsford Virtual School (AVS) but will be completed during school time using computers and resources in the CORE Pod Room (D116).

Class Expectations

Come to school prepared to work

Demonstrate appropriate interpersonal relationships within the group

Required Student Supplies
