Grading

Quizzes 15%

Tests 80%

Class Mark = 70% of total grade

Your grade in Math 11H is made up of 35% of term 1 and 35% of term 2. At the end of each term, a 5% bump is added on to each student's mark.

Final Exam = 30%

A two-and-a-half hour exam at the end of the semester accounts for almost a third of your grade. Students write the same exam as the Principles 11 classes but no 5% bump is added to the FINAL exam mark.

Calculator Use

Math 11H is a NON-CALCULATOR course. This means that ALL quizzes and tests are to be written WITHOUT A CALCULATOR. At the end of the year, a one week unit will be taught that does use a graphing calculator and calculators WILL BE ALLOWED for the final exam.
