Jay presented the new Yale app for smart phones, tablets and android devices. Feedback from students and staff are all very positive. Many additions still made to this app. Parents are encouraged to install and use it. Old agendas are considered obsolete now, cost of agendas \$10,000 per school year. App costs \$3,500 initially and \$1,000 every next year.

<u>Presentation on career and technical programs</u> by Clayton Radons and Brooke Ridedout

Clayton is not only a teacher at Yale but also the career program facilitator and he promotes the program through the district. Brooke is a 2013 Grad who has experience doing one of the programs as well as being able to promote it.

Program is quite unique for North America. Students not only get a hands-on approach in learning, they still earn Grade 12 credits. Students do their program in Abbotsford, Chilliwack or Langley. Different programs work with different schedules. Any student or parents can always get in touch with Mr. Radons for more information. Presentations are also given to all students at Yale. A 50% of all Grade kids apprentices are from Yale! This program is proven to be very successful.

Brooke's story: Sign up is in Grade 11, some programs get quite full. Mr. Radons helps with all paperwork and all that is required is a \$20 sign up fee. You have to take a "basic trades test" similar to a Grade 8 level Math test. For Grade 12 you still come to Yale for all your Grad requirement courses one semester. You then get accepted into an apprenticeship program which is also sponsored by Yale. Brooke needed to finish Grade 11 Math, Chem and Bio to be accepted into the Horticulture program. She was enrolled in a 6 week program at Kwantlen College. She then got a job at Devon Greenhouse a week after graduation! Brooke is continuing her Horticulture study.
