Presentation of PAC requests by Yale staff

Greg Byron for Misc. Athletics department

Is asking for \$2430 to purchase

- Field paint (lining of field 2x/wk for misc. sports, cost is \$1000 p/yr)
- Whistles for referees and coaches
- Water bottles for basketball team
- Rugby balls (15)
- Set pinnies (17, for soccer team)
- Medical supplies (tape, ice packs, heat balm)
- Rugby shoulder pads for previously injured children

All of these items are considered extra curricular

Willis Taylor for Musical Theatre

Is asking for Misc items for Musical Theatre, amounts as mentioned below.

- Set and props (period performance this year) \$1500
- Costumes (period performance this year) \$1500
- Microphones, 10 are needed but they are expensive. Yale is thinking of purchasing 2-3 each year to be able to have a whole new set of 10 in a few years. Cost is around \$912 each.

They will be practicing in theatre as of January 27, items are required before Christmas if possible. Woodworking class to help with construction of set.

All of these items are considered extra curricular

Iris Styran for Art department

Is asking for a slab roller for the amount of \$1433.60 or any part thereof

Item to be used in ceramics and clay classes. Approx. 300 students in Art class. Item to be used in all grades (9-12).

This item is considered to be a curricular expense.

Gary Macdonald for Doug Primrose request

Is asking for 5 TV's 40" to be used throughout the school for the amount of \$3000.

Old TV's will be moved to resource room. Gary McDonald will check on quote and to see where we can get best deal.

These items are considered extra curricular.

Christy Sandison for Music department

Is asking for two items for her band program

- Baritone Sax, replacing 20 year old sax. New sax costs \$4000.
- Piano. Two pianos in building but one will be replaced. Old one will be used throughout the school. Mrs. Sandison looking into baby grand piano, used cost at least \$4500. She will contact expert to check before purchase. Music budget will purchase rolling dock to move piano if necessary.

Musical instruments that are more expensive are usually purchased by the school for the students to use in band programs, and will remain at the school.

These items are considered curricular.

<u>Vice-Principal's Report</u> – Gary Macdonald

All is going very well in the school. Atmosphere within Yale (staff, admin, students and parents) is very positive. Grad meeting was well attended (around 120 parents). Good signup for sports and arts of all students. Leadership students are given the task of conveying to staff how to make dances within Yale more fun and safer for everyone. Staff has been challenged to make classes more entertaining and interesting. Good feedback from teachers and students about this.

Around \$26,000 after all expenses have been paid in the account. Our general account is getting very low, have to be careful with spending. Possibility of fundraising raised at PAC. We are open to all suggestions. Fundraising is hard because the different groups within Yale already do their own fundraising.

Grad Report – Diane Herbert

Teachers will be involved again under leadership of Gary Macdonald. Grade 11 parents are encouraged/needed/very welcome to volunteer for grad activities. Motion put forward by Rose Short for the purchase of 5 TV's 40" to be used throughout the school for announcements and pictures and such for the amount up to \$2000. Seconded by Leeanne Easton. All in favour.
