Principal's Report – Jay Pankratz

Good start of the new school year. Meet the teacher had a great turnout and the feedback from present PAC parents was very positive.

CSLC (Canadian Student Leadership Conference) -6 Yale students were there. It proved to be a very successful visit.

PBIS (School-Wide Positive Behaviors Interventions & Supports) has been implemented at Yale. Focus is more on positive than negative behavior. Next week Friday Block 2 will turn into double lunch time if students have no unfinished assignments. Students with work to be done will be required to do so and meet with teachers if needed to catch up. Idea for November is along same line, maybe then early dismissal for kids with no unfinished work. This applies to all Grade levels. Maybe added on: no unexcused absences. Ratio positive and negative should be around 4:1. This is a North American program supporting good behavior. Grade 12s might be in charge of giving out incentives to younger grades if they notice positive behavior.

Expansion LINK program (extra care for Grade 9 students). LINK members will touch base with the Grade 9s more often throughout the school year to support them in high school.
