

#### **Space Utilization of Rick Hansen Secondary Family of schools:**

**Rick Hansen Secondary** enrolment in September 2016 was 596, utilizing 52% of the schools operating capacity (1150) and enrolment is projected to grow to 70% utilization by 2030. Rick Hansen Secondary has long term room for district program growth.

#### In September 2016, Rick Hansen Secondary enrolment included:

- 576 regular students, of whom 513 (89.1%) reside within catchment and 63 (10.9%) who reside out of catchment.
- a net cross-catchment enrolment loss of regular students to other secondary schools in the district (inflow 63 less outflow 221 = -158).
- a comprehensive net cross catchment loss for all programs (inflow 67 less outflow 781 = -714).
- 6 international students not included in enrolment and utilization calculations.

**Eugene Reimer Middle** enrolment in September 2016 was 365, utilizing 65% of the schools operating capacity (600) and enrolment is projected to increase in 2017 to 460 students with 77% utilization in 2017. Enrolment will gradually grow to 85% utilization by 2030. Eugene Reimer Middle has long term room for program growth.

**Aberdeen Elementary** enrolment in September 2016 was 193, utilizing 70% of the schools operating capacity (275). The school will be reconfigured from K-7 to K-5 in 2017, resulting in only a slight loss in enrolment to 185, utilizing 69% of the revised operating capacity (268). The school's enrolment is projected to gradually grow to 88% utilization by 2030.

**Blue Jay Elementary** enrolment in September 2016 was 402, utilizing 106% of the schools operating capacity (377). The school has 1 portable on site for the long term, with projected enrolment remaining relatively level to 2030.

**Bradner Elementary** enrolment in September 2016 was 156, utilizing 99% of the schools operating capacity (158). The school will be reconfigured from K-7 to K-5 in 2017, resulting in only a loss in enrolment to 125, utilizing 80% of the revised operating capacity (155). Enrolment is projected to remain level between 2017 and 2030.

**Dave Kandal Elementary** enrolment in September 2016 was 262, utilizing 109% of the schools operating capacity (241). There are 3 short-term portable classrooms on site. Long term projections show a gradual decline in enrolment, with 92% utilization of the schools operating capacity by 2030.

Harry Sayers Elementary enrolment in September 2016 was 436, utilizing 123% of the schools operating capacity (354). There are 4 portable classrooms on site. The schools long term projections show a gradual decline in enrolment, with 103% utilization of the schools operating capacity by 2030.

**Mt. Lehman Elementary** enrolment in September 2016 was 163, utilizing 103% of the schools operating capacity (158). The school will be reconfigured from K-7 to K-5 in 2017, resulting in only a slight loss in enrolment to 153, utilizing 99% of the revised operating capacity (155). Enrolment is projected to remain level close to capacity between 2017 and 2030.

**Ross Elementary** enrolment in September 2016 was 215, utilizing 139% of the schools operating capacity (155). There are 4 portable classrooms on site. Enrolment is projected to grow utilizing approximately 158% of operating capacity within the next ten years.

### Alternative Accommodation Considerations, Rick Hansen Secondary Family of Schools:

The following are potential considerations for addressing the capacity/utilization and/or facility condition issues.

# 1) Capacity Project Alternatives:

- a) Status Quo No space additions
  - i) The Rick Hansen family of elementary schools are projected to remain underutilized, with most of the schools in the family having space for program growth. There are no District programs in any of the 9 schools in this family. The status quo alternative generally supports long term facility planning, with the exception of Ross Road Elementary which has long term space shortfall.
- b) Other considerations:
  - i) Addition to Ross Elementary

# 2) Program Alternatives:

- a) Status Quo No program changes
  - i) All existing programs and grade configurations would remain at current locations.
- b) Location of district programs.

# 3) Other Considerations to manage individual school capacity/utilization issues:

- i) Program moves/relocation
- b) Out of Catchment Enrolment Management

# 4) Facility upgrade (routine capital, replacement or major renovation) Alternatives:

- a) Status Quo No major upgrades
  - i) The FCI related condition of Rick Hansen Secondary, Bradner Elementary, Mount Lehman Elementary and Ross Elementary will need to be addressed in the future.
